Curriculum Goals:

The Manaaki Tāpoi Advanced programme will strengthen participants understanding both of the uniqueness of Māori culture as well as the interconnectedness of Te Ao Māori. The course builds on the Manaaki Tāpoi Introduction programme to develop further skills and ability to interact with manuhiri through the delivery of Māori tourism experiences.

Programme Delivery:

This course is delivered by Whenua Iiti Outdoors in a residential block format. There are four blocks in total, each block is four days in length.

- Discuss karakia tawhito and examine contemporary karakia as they apply to a Tourism Māori product
- Recite a karakia appropriate to a Tourism Māori product.
